Shea's Performing Arts Center to Cancel Performances of *Hello, Dolly!* and *The Curious Incident of the Dog in the Night-Time*

Buffalo, NY, March 12, 2020 –Under the direction of Governor Andrew Cuomo, Shea's Buffalo Theatre and Shea's 710 Theatre will cancel all remaining performances of *Hello, Dolly!* and *The Curious Incident of the Dog in the Night-Time* immediately in support of the health and well-being of the theatregoing public, as well as those who work in the theatre industry.

We urge all community members to practice caution and strictly follow the CDC's guidelines for preventing the spread of disease during this time. Shea's will continue to closely monitor the evolving coronavirus situation and make decisions as circumstances require, in accordance with guidelines from the CDC and state and local health officials.
