

# SAYING "HELLOOOOO" TO A NATIONAL TOUR WHAT HAPPENS DURING TECH?

Hellooooo National Tour! This month, Shea's Buffalo had the special honor of launching the National Tour of *Mrs. Doubtfire*. Launching a national tour is extra special as the cast and crew of the show make Buffalo their home for several weeks as tech rehearsals commence. For theatre, tech rehearsals are when the technological aspects of a show, like lights, sounds, props, costumes, sets, etc. are integrated into a show. As the inaugural stop, Shea's Buffalo holds an important part of the production's history, as adjustments made here will be carried on through future performances and locations of the tour.

The launch of *Mrs. Doubtfire* began with the set and orchestra loading into the theatre. While the set was assembled on and adjusted to the Shea's Buffalo stage, the orchestra conducted rehearsals in our lobby. There, tempos, dynamics, etc. were adjusted to make it perfect for performances. The upbeat and fun music of *Mrs. Doubtfire* rang through the halls of Shea's Buffalo during this step of the launch process.



Before arriving at Shea's, the actors from the National Tour rehearsed in New York City. The actors practiced with props and some set pieces before making the journey up to Buffalo to put the whole show together. Stand-ins for costumes, like glasses and aprons were used before the full costume transformations were incorporated. Once in Buffalo, the actors rehearsed on the Shea's

Buffalo stage, finally bringing all the different aspects of a theatre performance- lights, sound, sets, orchestra, actors, and stagehands together into one complete show.

There was one final dress rehearsal the evening before the show opened on Sunday, September 24th. Mrs. Doubtfire has been deemed an instant crowd-pleaser by Buffalo audiences. Broadway favorite Rob McClure stars as Daniel Hillard/Mrs. Doubtfire with his real-life wife, Maggie Lakis as Miranda Hillard. The pair have said Buffalo is an ideal place to open a show like Mrs. Doubtfire because of the family audiences that come to attend performances at Shea's.







The hustle-and-bustle around the show did not die down after its opening. Press interviews, photo shoots, B-roll filming, Instagram takeovers (thank you Sara Schultz and Jonathan Hoover!), and more filled the Shea's Buffalo lobby during the day- another important part of opening a tour!



#### **ROOF REPLACEMENT PROJECT**

#### AN UPDATE!

Towards the end of August, work began on replacing a section of the roof at Shea's Buffalo Theatre above our Grand Lobby. As mentioned in our May issue of the Call-Board, water is the enemy of Shea's Buffalo, and replacement of the roof systems is needed to safeguard the assets in the building and preserve our gorgeous historic ceilings. Replacing the roof above our Grand Lobby by the City of Buffalo helped us complete part of this necessary project. Designed by Foit-Albert Associates, Architecture, Engineering and Surveying, P.C. and roofing conducted by Jameson Roofing Co., Inc., the project has since been completed.

Additional funding is still needed to complete the replacement of all roof systems including the roof over the auditorium at Shea's Buffalo Theatre. The total cost for the roof replacement project is over four million dollars.



# IT'S THE SHEA'S HIGH SCHOOL MUSICAL THEATRE AWARDS

#### THE LAUNCH OF A NEW EDUCATION PROGRAM!

We are so excited to announce the launch of our inaugural Shea's High School Musical Theatre awards! This new program is a dynamic initiative designed to celebrate and support the arts in high schools, foster excellence in musical theatre, and provide valuable educational opportunities for students. This program is deeply committed to nurturing young talent, promoting collaboration, and building a strong sense of community within the world of musical theatre.

Instead of an application process, Shea's will implement a straightforward registration



system to encourage more school and student participation. Registration for the Shea's High School Musical Theatre Awards opens Friday, October 6th. Shea's will also expand the panel of adjudicators in the program. The selection process will aim to bring in adjudicators with diverse perspectives and expertise, aligning with the commitment to diversity, equity, and inclusion. The evaluation rubric used for judging will be revised to provide clearer and more transparent scoring. This change is in response to valuable feedback from teachers and aims to improve the adjudication process.

Finally, the awards structure will be modified to benefit a broader range of schools. While still recognizing outstanding productions, Shea's will introduce additional monetary awards beyond the single school recognized for Outstanding Production of a Musical. This change aims to support more schools and foster a sense of shared achievement and encouragement within the entire community.
