WELCOME TO THE MOULIN ROUGE A BRIEF HISTORY OF THE TITULAR INSPIRATION FOR MOULIN ROUGE! THE MUSICAL

Did you know the Moulin Rouge club featured in both MOULIN ROUGE! THE MUSICAL and the 2001 Baz Luhrmann movie is based on a real, famous, French nightclub?

Though the stories of the movie and musical are fictional, the real Moulin Rouge club has been open at the foot of Montmarte hill since October 6th 1889. It was founded by Joseph Oller and Charles Zidler (who you can see fictionalized onstage in the musical as the eccentric host, Harold Zidler). Le Moulin Rouge club became a hub for the rich to "slum" it in a fashionable part of town and for poorer artists living

a more alternative "Bohemian" lifestyle to express themselves in a freer environment. The characters you see onstage in MOULIN ROUGE! THE MUSICAL fall into these classes.

The Moulin Rouge is known for shaping entertainment as we know it today. The famous "Can-Can" dance originated in the club as a challenge to restrictive social norms at the time. The careers of important artists and entertainers have also been intertwined with the nightclub's history. Famous artist Henri de Toulouse Lautrec made posters for the Moulin Rouge beginning in 1891, the first being the well-known "La Goulue" poster. (You can also find a fictionalized version of him in the musical). Mistinguett, who at one point was the highest-paid female entertainer in the world, also performed frequently at the Moulin Rouge.

Later, after the first world war and a change in ownership in the club, Mistinguett would become artistic director for the Moulin Rouge, creating splashy revues that would eventually inspire Las Vegas performances.

As the century continued on, the Moulin Rouge experienced changes and renovations, becoming a genuine, contemporary nightclub in the 1930s, a classier venue for international artists in the 1950s, and even welcomed an aquarium for an aquatic ballet in the 1960s. The '60s were a formative time for Le Moulin Rouge on a creative level as well; in 1963 their hit revue LE FROU FROU started their ongoing trend of performing revues starting with the letter F.

October of 2019 marked the Moulin Rouge's 130th anniversary, reminding everyone that the Moulin Rouge is a long-standing cultural icon. You have five chances left to see the spirit of this iconic venue onstage in MOULIN ROUGE! THE MUSICAL at Shea's Buffalo theatre.

PROGRESS ON PEARL STREET AN UPDATE ON RESTORING THE PEARL STREET VESTIBULE

In our July edition of the Call-Board we let you know about the restoration project occurring in our Pearl Street Vestibule. Multiple materials were used in an earlier repair of the wall, causing different sections of the wall to expand and contract at different rates when under temperature fluctuations. Since we last covered the project, tremendous progress has been made!

During the month of August, our talented restoration team was able to gradually chip, chisel, and remove the old deteriorated under plaster down to the original surface of fire brick. The bricks were individually wire brushed to remove any



brushed to remove any lingering old surface debris. They were then coated with Plasterweld,

a glue like bonding agent,

creating a fun pink color!

New wire lath was attached to cover any areas lacking fire brick and then the initial layer of scratch coat was applied. By August 18th, the first layer was finally finished.

This started the long process of adding layer after layer of plaster to meet up with the depth of the original wall, which was two to two and a half

inches thick. Eighteen to twenty bags, or five hundred pounds of dry plaster has been applied so far. No small feat!

The raised area near the handrail displays the original depth of the wall. Layer upon layer of plaster was applied to match the original thickness.

Each section needed to dry and, in places, be sanded before application of subsequent layers to eventually reach a level surface. Fluctuating Buffalo temperatures and the opening of the 2023-2024 Broadway Season prolonged this drying and sanding process, however.

October 17th was the last working day for the plaster application, in preparation for the load-in of MOULIN ROUGE! THE MUSICAL. After the show, weather permitting, the final finishing detail work can continue, eventually culminating with the final priming and painting techniques to the restore the wall back to its former appearance.
