DECORATING SHEA'S BUFFALO THEATRE FOR THE HOLIDAYS

It's the most wonderful time of the year! In early November, Shea's Buffalo and Shea's 710 were decorated for the holiday season. Over the course of 48 hours, a talented team of 9-12 people from Hale Northeastern came to complete the installation process, in collaboration with our wonderful Environmental Services staff.

Our decorations were given an update in 2021, after the Covid lockdown. They were refreshed to match the opulent beauty of Shea's Buffalo, with the décor on the Grand Staircase being exceptionally decadent. The decorations were created with the intricate design and colors that define Shea's. The most recent example of this was the incorporation of the iconic Tiffany Blue color found in the domed ceilings of Shea's Buffalo. Hale Northeastern introduced a French Blue that was an extremely close match in a variety of antique style globe, onion, and finial shaped ornaments.



Nowhere is this more evident than in the magnificent Grand Tree that is placed at the very top landing of the grand lobby staircase. This year, the tree was upgraded to an astonishing 12-foot height. It was set upon a 2-foot base, making the tree tower above the main lobby at 14-feet! At its base, the tree is 6 feet wide. It's a stunning picture, decked with gold and the previously mentioned French blue ornaments. The Grand Tree is given extra sparkle with nearly 2,000 lights! The goal of Hale Northeastern and Shea's was to have our guests look up in awe

It's summer, the cicadas are singing, and the Lafayette family has returned to their late patriarch's Arkansas home to deal with the remains of his estate. Toni (Sarah Paulson), the eldest daughter, hopes they'll spend the weekend remembering and reconnecting over their beloved father. Bo (Corey Stoll), her brother, wants to recoup some of the funds he spent caring for Dad at the end of his life. But things take a turn when their estranged brother, Franz, appears late one night, and mysterious objects are discovered among the clutter. Suddenly, longhidden secrets and buried resentments can't be contained, and the family is forced to face the ghosts of their past.

PEARL STREET UPDATES

HOW OUR RESTORATION TEAM RESTORES CROWN MOLDING.

In our last edition of the Callboard, we featured an update to the restoration of our Pearl Street Vestibule. Our restoration department has started the next step in the process- stripping and repainting the crown molding. The molding in the Pearl Street vestibule was removed and sorted into groups, so that the original, uniquely shaped and placed, pieces remained together.

Paint stripper was applied to the moldings, sometimes revealing up to six to eight layers of various colored paint! Displayed in the picture below are the various stages involved in stripping down to the original raw wood.



Some paint layers were easily removed revealing the raw wood. Other paints proved to be more difficult. Some moldings were covered in what appeared to be a sort of "crackle paint." However, with determination and perseverance all of the paint was removed down to the raw wood.

Once the paint was stripped away, the wood was sanded to remove any remnants of paint that may have been missed. Cracks, chips, and dents made through years of wear and tear, were then filled with wood epoxy and putty to restore the wood into one unit again.

The next step involves applying a base coat of primer. Then two layers of a cream hue, oil paint are applied before the final glazing. Our glaze is amber in color made from half paint and half medium, made of dammar varnish, distilled turpentine, and refined linseed oil. Once the wet glaze is applied the highlight points on the molding would then be wiped off, creating dimension. Then, a dry brush is wiped across the wet glaze to create striations of a natural wood grain look.

During the writing of this article, all of the moldings were remounted back to their original places. As we're nearing the completion of the project the final painting and glazing will soon commence. Stay tuned!
