RESTORATION AT A GLANCE

IT'S MINOR REPAIRS AND TOUCH UPS SEASON

With a schedule packed with programming, our restoration team has hit the phase of accessing areas of needed work that will become summer projects, touching up smaller plaster repair projects, and finalizing ongoing projects.

If you have attended a show recently at Shea's Buffalo and walked through our Pearl Street Vestibule, you will have seen that the large restoration of the walls has been finished with the last of the painting and glazing work.





The 2nd floor men's restroom also had plaster repair work done just in time for the opening of FUNNY GIRL. Temperature fluctuations and vibrations from the moving of individuals, objects, and sound waves from the shows cause fractures and cracks to appear in the plaster due to its delicacy and sensitivity. The basement level men's restroom will need similar repairs and restoration. This has been identified as a summer project due to the estimated time and expansive repair needed.

Currently, the fourth-floor staircases leading to the uppermost level of the balcony each have the attention of our restoration team. Plaster, painting, and glazing work is needed. Additional touch ups are needed at railings, and the arm rests of our icon thrones.









Another upcoming summer project is restoring a portion of plaster wall and molding that has not been restored since 1926. If you are able, on your next trip to the theatre see if you can spot it. Hint: the paint and glazing are dull and chipped compared to the restored areas around it.


