PROTECT YOUR EYES! TEAMING UP WITH THE BUFFALO MUSEUM OF SCIENCE FOR SOLAR ECLIPSE SAFTEY

It's the talk of the city! On Monday, April 8th, Buffalo will experience a once in a lifetime phenomenon of a total solar eclipse. Shea's and The Buffalo Museum of Science wants you to have your eclipse glasses ready.

Thanks to generous funding from Erie County, complimentary eclipse glasses are available at the Buffalo Museum of Science (limit two per person) as well as at

your local library while supplies last. Be sure to check your eclipse glasses for scratches as they will make your glasses unsafe for use.

What makes eclipse glasses special? They contain specialized solar filters that allows you to view the partially or uneclipsed sun while not injuring your eyes. During the brief period of totality, you can view the eclipse with your naked eye but be mindful to switch back to your eclipse glasses once that period is over.

TOUCH-UPS CONTINUE OUR RESTORATION TEAM IS EVERYWHERE

From the top of the balcony to the emergency exit doors in the orchestra level, our restoration team is racking up a lot of steps...and a lot of plaster and paint.

Below is the current progress on the replaster and painting of a section of wall at the rear of the balcony. A combination of ragging, stippling, and dry brushing to match the original paint.



To the right is a portion of orchestra emergency exit stairs that needed similar plaster and touch up work. Much of the walls and doors in the orchestra will need similar repair and restoration.

GET TO KNOW THE MUSICALS & PLAYS ON BROADWAY

THE WHO'S TOMMY Nederlander Theatre

In 1967, The Who created a rock opera that changed the course of music history.

Some 25 years later, The Who's TOMMY arrived on Broadway, winning 5 Tony Awards and pushing the boundaries of what musical theatre can be. This March, the Amazing Journey resumes in a dazzling new production direct from a recordbreaking, groundbreaking Chicago premiere.

Myth and spectacle combine in a fresh reinvention of The Who's exhilarating 1969 rock concept album, Tommy including the unforgettable anthems "I'm Free," "See Me, Feel Me," "Sensation" and "Pinball Wizard." After witnessing his father shoot his rival, the young Tommy Walker is lost in the universe, endlessly and obsessively staring into the mirror. An innate knack for pinball catapults him from reticent adolescent to celebrity savior. Below is the process on a panel in the third floor Pearl Street primary tunnel into the house. Subject to temperature fluctuations, vibrations of sound waves and foot traffic, the plaster began to crack. Our restoration team aimed to remove only the portion of the panel with the crack but it was discovered the damage continued through most of the panel and the whole of it needed repair.



Before plaster can be layed an adhesive layer is placed down first. This is used to bind the plaster so it will adhere to the wall. That adhesive layer can be seen peaking out in the bottom left corner image before the white plaster covers it.
